February 2009 In a word, investigative reporting can be defined as broadcasters' or newspaper companies' own news reports that do not depend on press releases, or news articles that media outlets announce on their own responsibilities. In the United States, investigative journalism flourished in the late 1960's through the 1970's. Newspapers devoted significant space to historical investigative reports such as the leaking of the Pentagon Papers and the Watergate Scandal. However, in the 1990's, investigative reporting in the U.S. went into a nosedive. And in the 21st century, with a series of acquisitions of newspaper companies, media executives' priority have become making a profit and cost reduction, and expensive investigative reporting has become a money pit for them. Then, what is the current situation of investigative reporting in Japan? As long as reading papers and watching television, media outlets seem to be competing with one another in investigative reports. However, more people have become alliterate and have lost interest in television, and these trends are directly hitting the media. Although there is an overflow of information, the age of the Internet has generated new generations of people who do not read papers, do not watch news, and do not buy magazines because most university students are said to be satisfied with only reading online news. However, the further the age of the Internet progresses, the more important role investigative report will need to play, in order to highlight the existence value of newspapers and broadcasters. Now is the time to examine the meaning of investigative reporting.
