Photoshop is an extraordinary tool to alter the reality, but it's really fantastic when you are aware of its effects. These detection techniques aside, almost all the photographs you see on the newsstand have received at least a slight alteration, and it is not necessarily a bad thing. For only educational purposes, I gave Mark Zuckerberg a new face to illustrate some false detection points. You can see both images above - the original is on the left and the altered version is on the right (if it's not obvious). The eyes that I decided to give Zuckerberg the dreamy eyes of Zack Efron (which, I think, were already quite photoshopped to start). Note how white they are. The movie-star seems or not, all the eyes have veins and other imperfections in the scleras to try to make them a little less false-perfect, but nothing too excessive. Nevertheless, if you see really white eyes you can assume that someone has been photoshopping on the image. The most beautiful faces are quite dynamic, topographically speaking and the eyes are a great example. Even if the eyes can sometimes seem a little flat in a photo (thanks to good lighting and probably a little help from Photoshop in post), generally you will find some areas in a photo that has collected the shadows. If this is the case, try determining if the shadows are realistic for your face. If you look at the right eye in both pictures of Zuckerberg, you will see that the shadow to the right of it has changed rather a little. The original shadow didn't work with the original eye, so I tried to correct it. Nevertheless, you can see that the eye is not sinking as much as the shadow. This could have been helped with a little deformation and painted by hand, but there is only so much that you can do. The poor perspective is always a good indicator of a fake. The nose in this photo is probably the most unrealistic part of it, and it's not just because it belongs to Taylor Swift. Nosas are particularly difficult because they need to have both the texture and the right color of the rest of the face. If a new nose is transplanted or altered, it is a bit of a challenge to keep things in progress. In this particular nose, there are some things to note. One, despite my efforts to tell the nose with the freckled skin of Zuckerberg, you can still see the smooth skin and freckling of Swift. You may not be obvious at first sight, but if you look at your nose you'll start to see it. Part of this is also due to the difference in lighting, since the transitions between the topographical phases of the nostrils and notice how a little red are. Using technology analysis software can help you detect unrealistic features of an image, but this software is generally quite expensive. Image error level analysis is a tool that creates an image similar to a map of Heat from a JPEG that shows you the highest compression points.
